

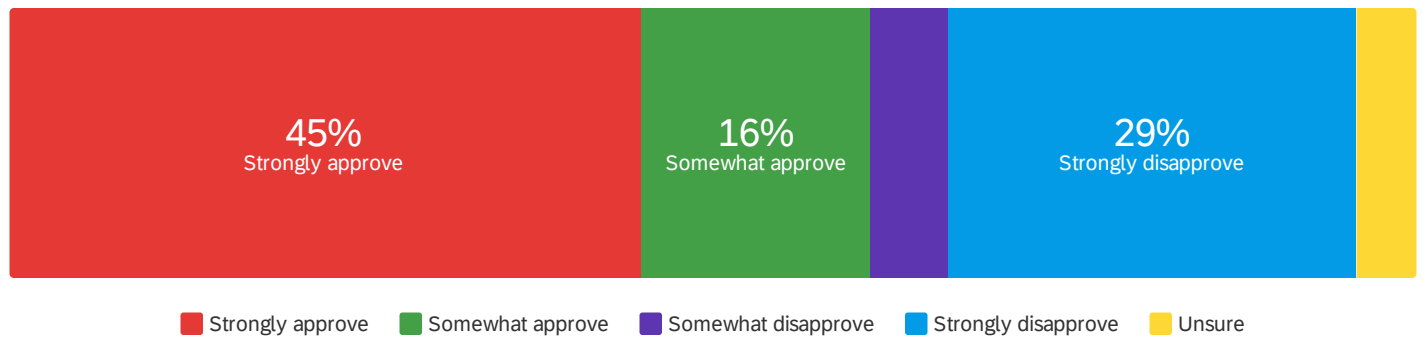

Total Approve (61.16%), Total Disapprove (34.56%)



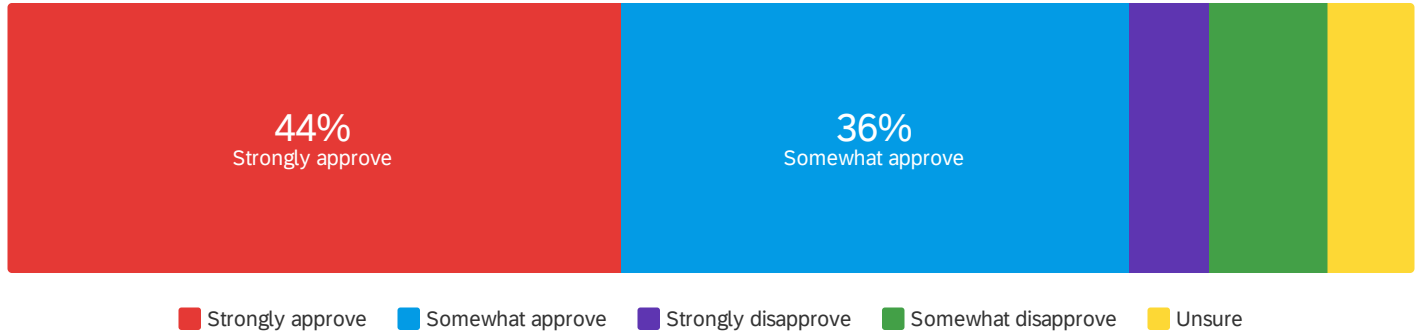

(COVID-19) pandemic in Arkansas?

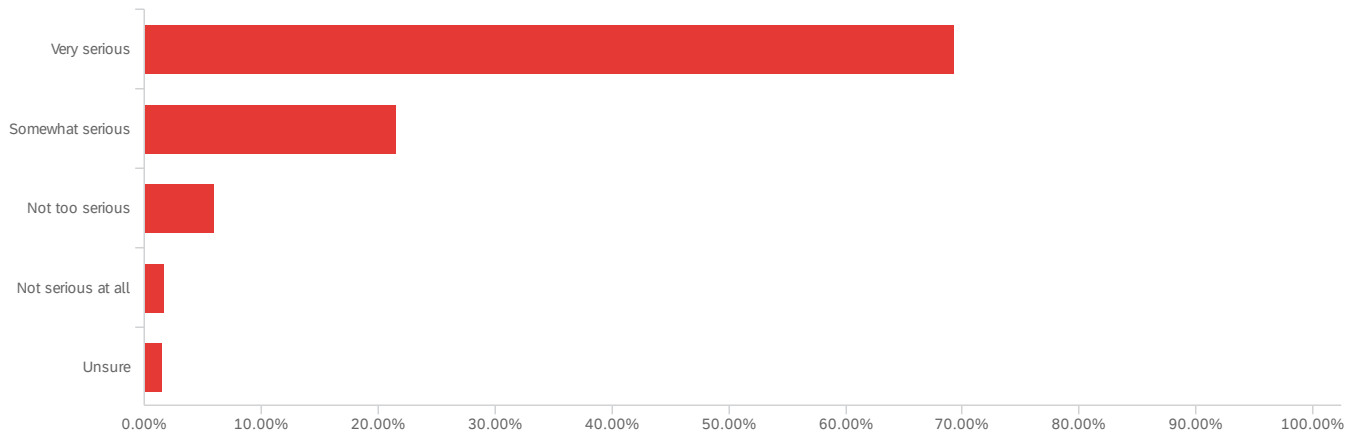

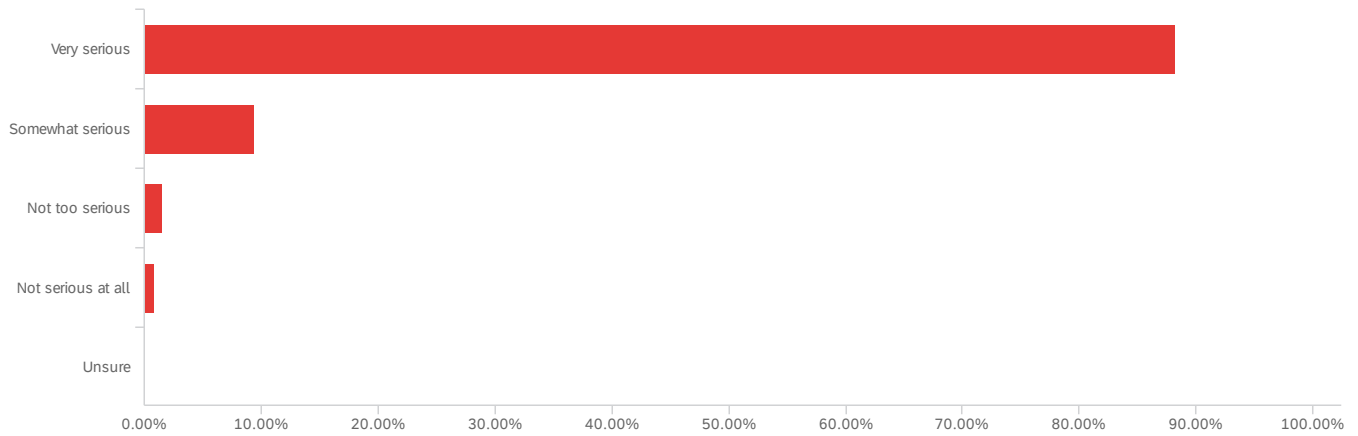
Q3 - In your opinion, how serious of a threat is coronavirus to our public health?

Q5 - As national and state officials make policy decisions to best respond to the coronavirus pandemic, what should be their top priority?

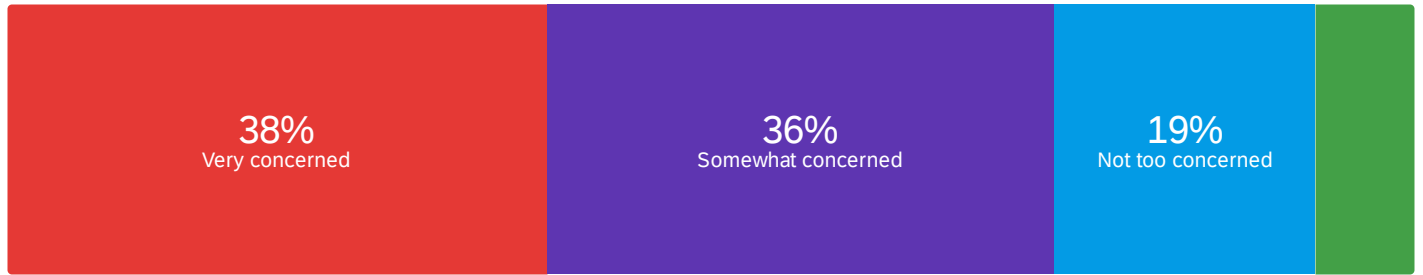

Q6 - How concerned are you about the availability of coronavirus tests in your area?

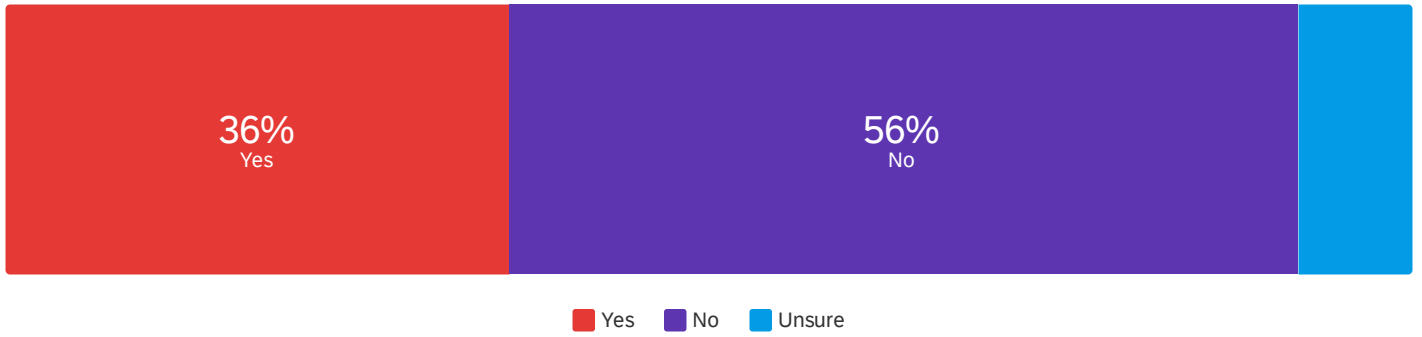

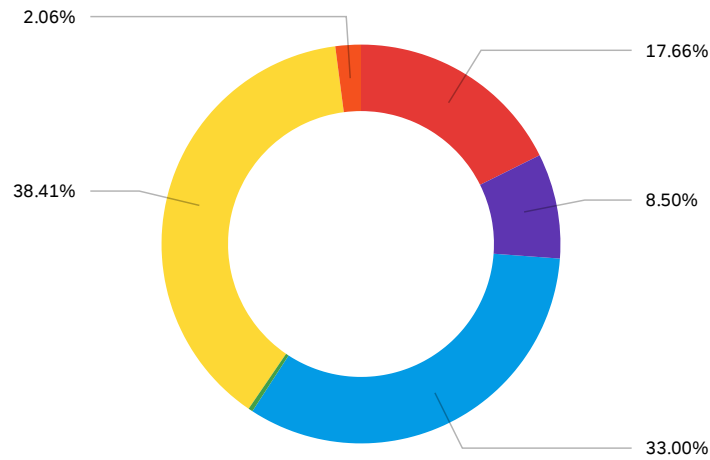
Q7 - Do you blame the Trump Administration for the slow rollout and shortage of coronavirus testing?

Q8 - If you don't blame the Trump Administration for the slow rollout and shortage of coronavirus tests, then who do you blame?



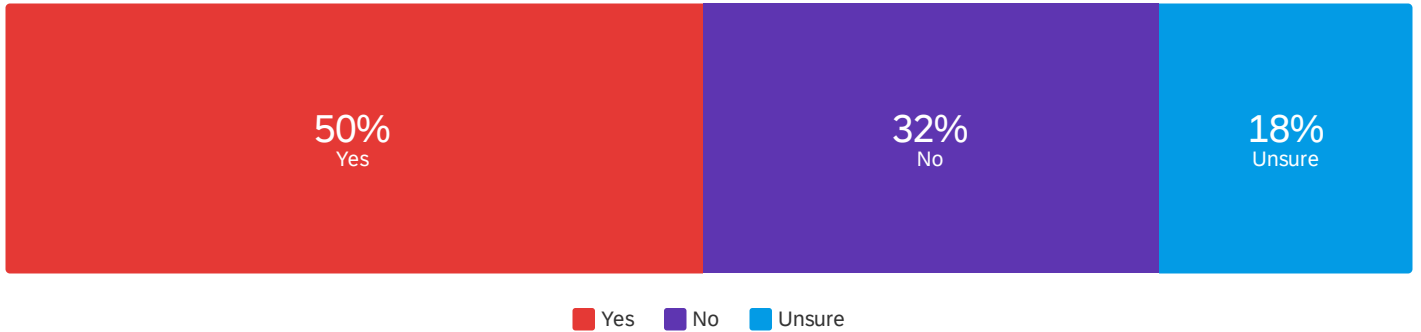

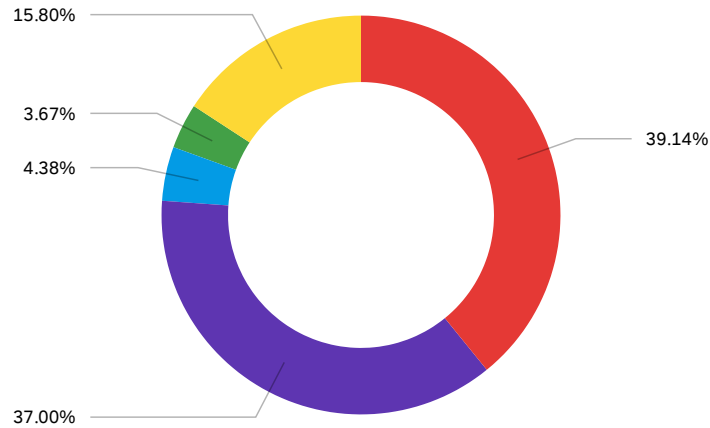

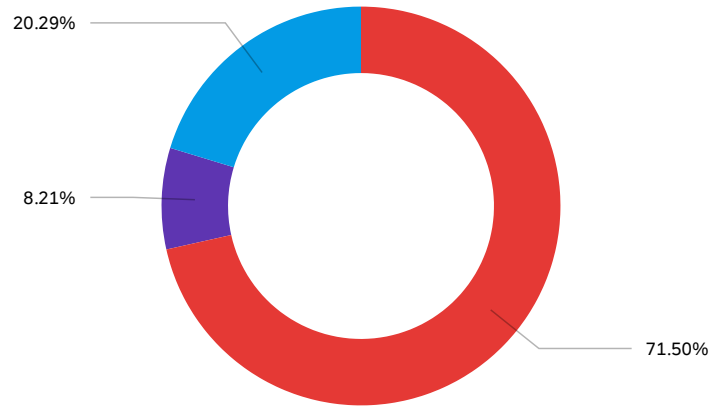

Q13 - Are you currently performing your job using tele-working or are you still going to your place of employment to work?

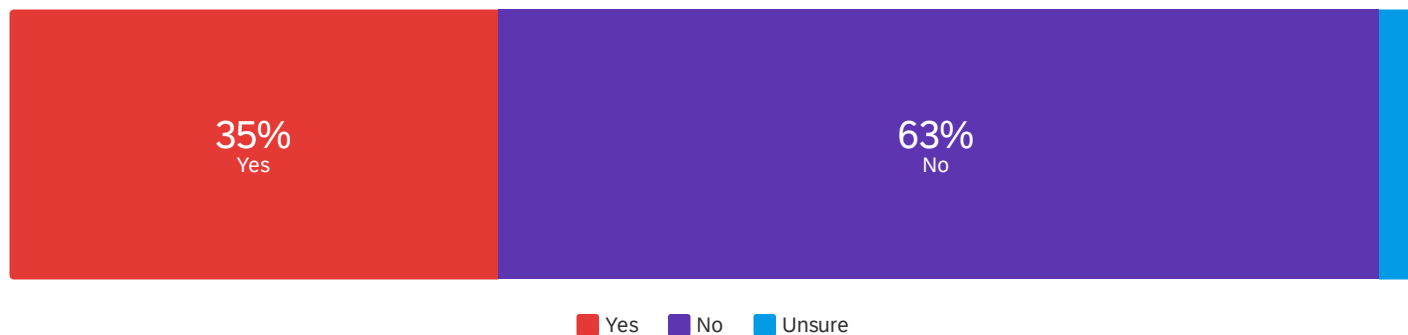

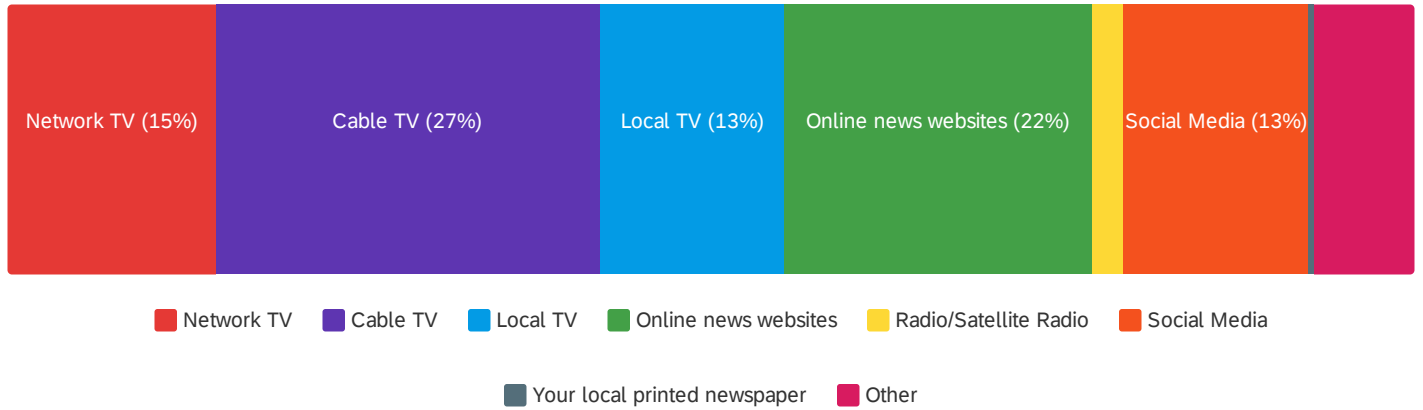

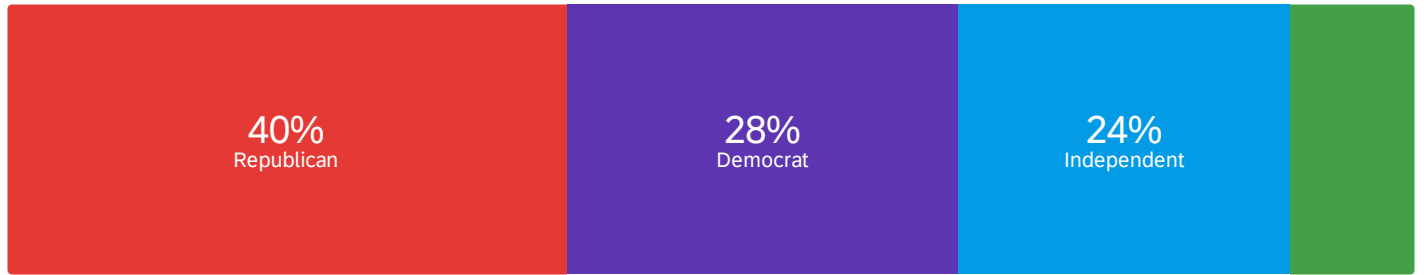
Q16 - What is your primary news source for obtaining information about coronavirus?

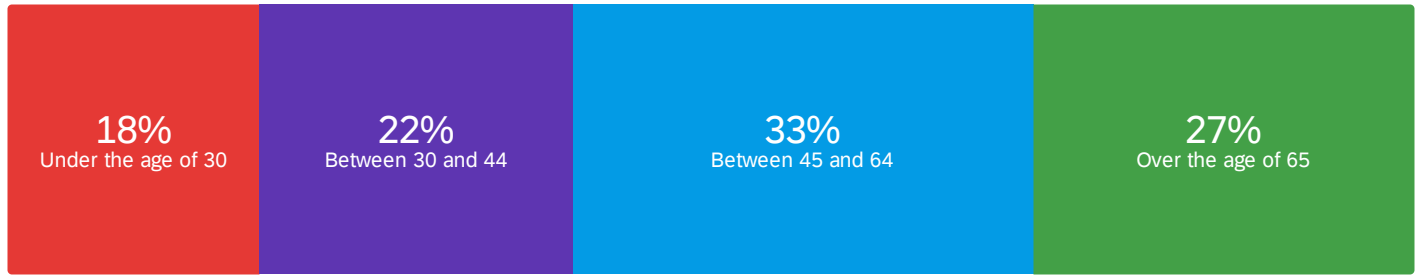

Q18 - For Statistical Purposes, please tell us your age.

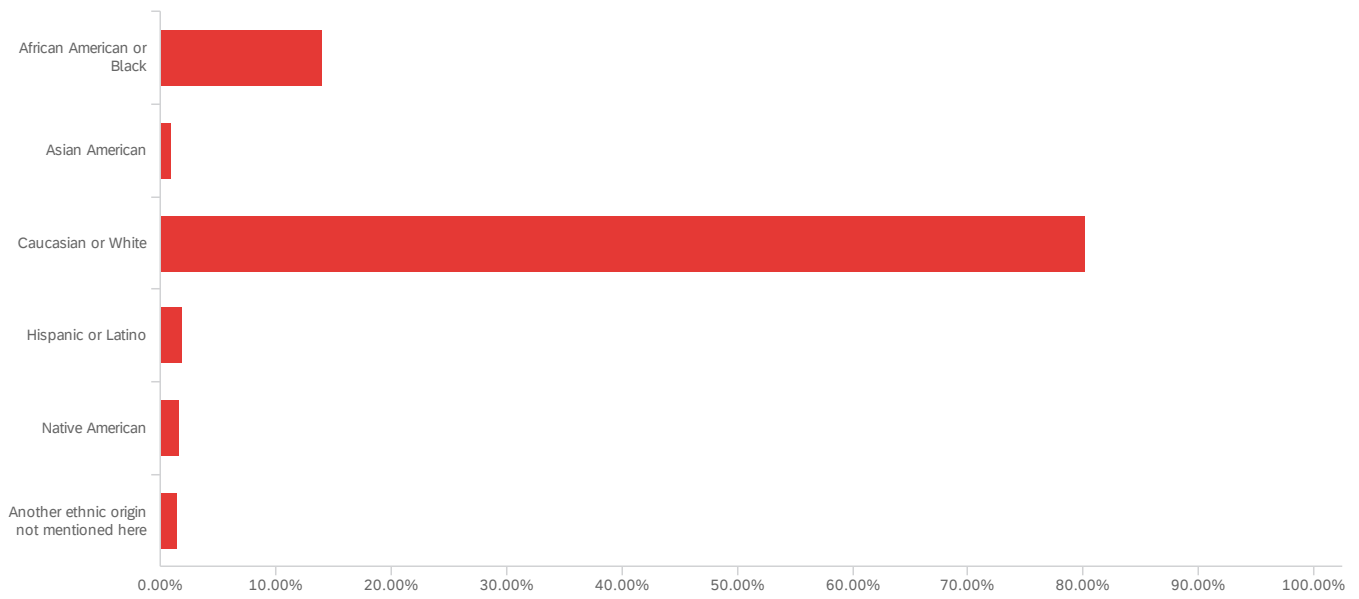

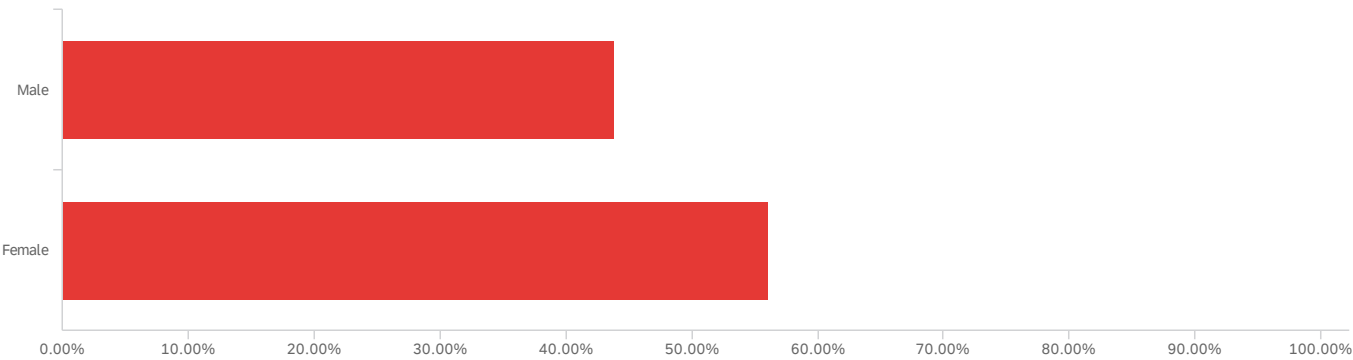
